

Porsche SE: Matthias Müller resigns as member of the executive board

Stuttgart, 30 April 2018. Matthias Müller, member of the executive board responsible for strategy and corporate development of Porsche Automobil Holding SE (Porsche SE), Stuttgart, has resigned from his position in agreement with the supervisory board effective 30 April 2018. In this context, it was agreed with Matthias Müller that the benefits to which he is entitled under his contract will be honored in full.
